

Prescriptions

If you live more than 1 mile from a chemist, your surgery can Dispense* medication to you. Delivery options may also be available, please ask your dispenser.

You can order your repeat prescription online if you are registered for this service, or you can drop your white prescription sheet off at the surgery. Please allow 48 hours (2 working days) for the prescription to be raised / made up. Your prescription may be withheld pending a review with your Doctor or the Nurse – please attend for these reviews when called.

*Please note that The New Surgery is not a dispensing site.



Investigations & Results

From time to time, your Doctor may order either routine or urgent investigations such as blood tests, scans and x-rays. These are usually ordered electronically, and the results are returned to the Doctor who ordered them. Once they have been reported on by your Doctor, the results are made available to you. Please call your surgery after 2pm for the results of your test(s). Please do not ask for test results that have been ordered by your consultant, as these go directly to them. In some cases, the Doctor may ask you to book a telephone or face to face appointment to discuss these results; however, it is the responsibility of the patient to enquire after the result.

Patient Rights and Responsibilities

You will be treated as an individual and will be given courtesy and respect at all times. You have the right to be treated confidentially. We have respect for race, gender, religion and disability.

We expect patients to extend the same approach to all members of the practice team. Action may be taken if a patient is violent or abusive, and they may be removed from the practice register.

Carers

If you provide care on a regular basis for a child, relative, partner or neighbour who is unable to manage alone owing to illness, disability, frailty, mental distress or impairment, please tell us so that we can make a note on our patient records and provide you with any help you may need. New Patient Registration

We welcome all patients within each surgery's catchment area. We are happy to register patients who live outside these catchment areas but please speak with a practice member as not all services may be available to you. Please ask our reception staff for more information. If you take regular medication, please also hand in a copy of your repeat prescription.

Appointments

Appointments can be booked in a number of ways:

- In advance, over the telephone or in person, or online through the surgery website (please ask the receptionist to register you for online access)
- Some situations can be dealt with by having a telephone consultation with your Doctor
- If you no longer need your appointment, please inform the surgery so that your appointment may be offered to another patient.
- Nursing appointments can vary in length – please let the receptionist know why you want the appointment, so that you can be allotted the correct amount of time
- Home visits are available for the household and for patients too ill to attend surgery – please book by 10:00 if possible.

When allocating Emergency/On-the-Day Urgent appointments you may be asked by a receptionist to provide some guidance or information on your ailments or symptoms. Please note that all staff abide by strict confidentiality and data protection guidelines and this information is used to ensure that we prioritise and allocate appointments safely.

If your surgery is closed and you need medical assistance please call 111. In the event of an emergency that cannot wait until the surgery reopens please call 999.
